Shalom © Here's the application you've been waiting for from Camp Young Judaea! We hope you will be joining us for the summer of 2010.

Please complete both sides of the application and return it to me **immediately**, with your deposit. New camper applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, based on when we receive it. The earlier you send it back to us, the better your chances! We promise this is not some hard-sell marketing technique: most of our age groups do fill up quickly. Additional registration forms can be downloaded from our Web site at www.cyj.org in the Prospective Camper section under "Registration."

During the month of November, we register returning campers and their siblings. Starting December 1st, we begin accepting new campers, based on when we received the registration form in November. This means we will not process your check until after Dec. 1st. If we don't have room for your child, we'll return your check. Notification letters will be sent out by December 10th.

Please note: We WILL NOT accept hand-carried applications to our office. We will only accept registration forms sent via regular US mail, FedEx (no signature required, please!) or other overnight delivery services. PLEASE DO NOT send applications by registered, certified mail or any mail service requiring our signature; this may actually delay your registration!!

DATES AND COSTS

Dates for next year are Thursday June 24 to Sunday July 18 for our first session; second session is Monday July 19 to Thursday August 12. Visiting Day (for two-month campers only) will be held Sunday July 18. The cost for one session is \$3,150 tuition plus a \$200 camp fee (\$3,350); the cost for the full seven-week session is \$5,795 plus a \$400 camp fee (\$6,195). We require a deposit of \$400 for a one-session camper and \$500 for a two-month camper. The balance is due no later than April 1, 2010 or is subject to cancellation.

First-time campers may be eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship from the Foundation for Jewish Camping. These scholarships are not needs-based! Log on to www.onehappycamper.org after November 1 for more information.

We've included information about our upcoming Open House and Reunion on Sunday November 29th. The best time for new campers to come is around 2 p.m. If you do come, please stop by the registration desk and introduce yourself to us!
